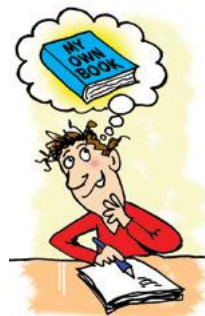
Spelling Bee News

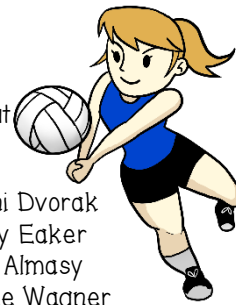
