The 8th grade graduation will take place on Tuesday, May 23rd at 7:00 pm. There will be cake and punch served after the ceremony. Come out and wish



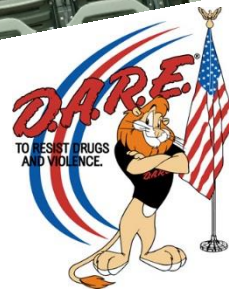
1st Grade News

Track Team

The track team has been working very hard this year and as the end of the season draws near, many of the athletes have obtained their best results of the year! In the Conference Meet, Connor Barnes won the shot put, was runner up in discus, and ribboned in each of his events! Tenley Searle was Conference Champion in the 800m, earned 2nd place in the discus, and also ribboned in all of her other events. Garret Poepsel raced to a 3rd place finish in the hurdles. Tayte Albritton placed 2nd in the 800m and 3rd in the mile and Tyce Albritton took 4th place in the 800m.

Connor Barnes continued his impressive performance by earning County runner-up in both the shot put and discus, not to mention coming in within 1st of the school record on his best throw of the day in shot put! Garret Poepsel again took 3rd in the hurdles. Tayte Albritton once again performed well with a 2nd place finish in the 800m and a 3rd place finish in the 1600m. Jace Wilerson impressively jumped his way to County runner-up in the high jump and Damien Brown earned 4th place. Tenley Searle added two 3rd place finishes in both the 800m and discus. The 7th grade boys' team finished in 3rd place in the County meet this year!

Finally, in the St. Phil's Invitational, the 7th grade boys took a very respectable 4th place out of 18 teams! Connor Barnes and Tayte Albritton lead the team with Connor earning the shot put and discus titles, while Tayte took home the title in the 1600m. Teammates Ben Riggerbach and Bowen Anderson joined the two frontrunners for the 4x400 relay, where they earned 2nd place!
