Track

The track season is winding down. The team has worked really hard this year and is one that we can be proud of. They just finished competing in three ribbon meets, the Bethel Lutheran Invite, Conference, and County.

Top results for those include Connor Barnes- 1st place in shot put in the Bethel Invite, as well as 2nd place in both Conference and County. He also got first place in the discus at the Bethel Invite and was Conference champion in it as well. Jack Brooks won first place in the 400 at the Bethel Invite and second place in both Conference and County. Camden Gardner was County runner-up in the 100 m dash. The 4x400 relay team of Seth Bollinger, Camden Gardner, Jack Brooks, and Connor Barnes were County runner-up. Many other boys on the team had great performances and set PRs (personal records) as well.

Top girl results included Myah Lopez winning first place in the shot put at the Bethel Invite. She was also third place in the discus at County. Leilani Dvorak earned second place in both the 100 and 200 at the Bethel Invite as well as third in the high jump. She then was Conference runner-up in the long jump. Taja MacPhee placed third in the shot put at both the Bethel Invitational and County. Finally, the relay team of Myah Lopez, Taja MacPhee, Bianca Wike, and Leilani Dvorak finished in third place at the County ribbon meet.

The team has their Sectional meet on Saturday. Please stay tuned to see if any team members qualify for the State Track Meet at Eastside.
