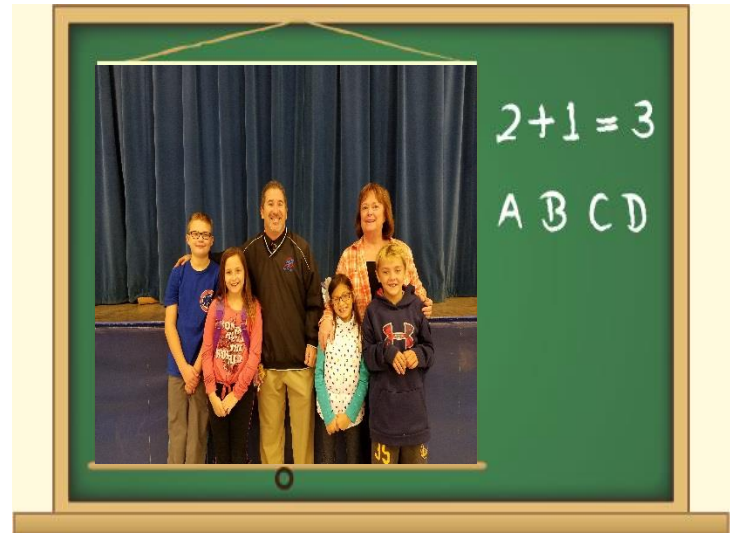

Did you know?

- Only 18% of parents use reflective tape on their children's Halloween costumes.
- On average twice as many child pedestrians are killed while walking on Halloween compared to any other day.
- 12% of children 5-years of age or younger are permitted to walk alone trick-or-treating.

Make this Halloween a safe one by following some of these simple safety rules...

1. Children under 12 should trick-or-treat and cross streets with an adult.
2. Always walk on sidewalks or paths and if there are no sidewalks, walk facing traffic as far to the side as possible.
3. Cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks. Parents should remind children to watch for cars that are turning or backing up.
