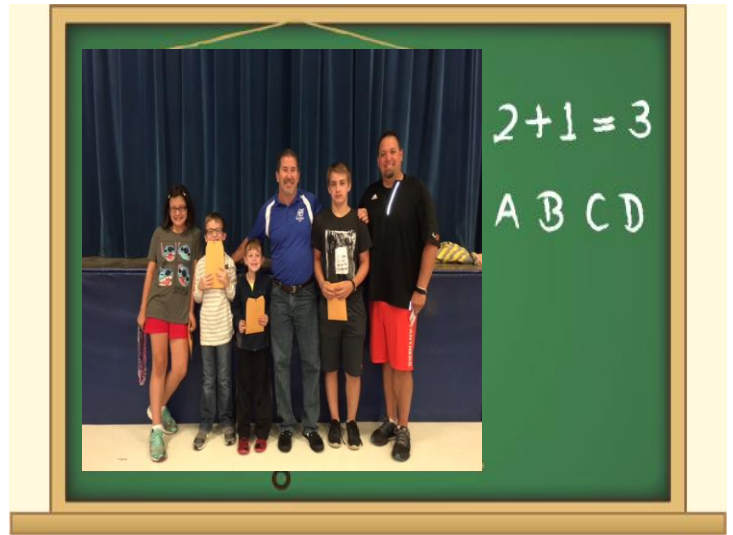
## PBIS News

Student Council elections will begin next week. Students interested in student council should see Mr. Suchocki or Mr. Kennedy for more information.

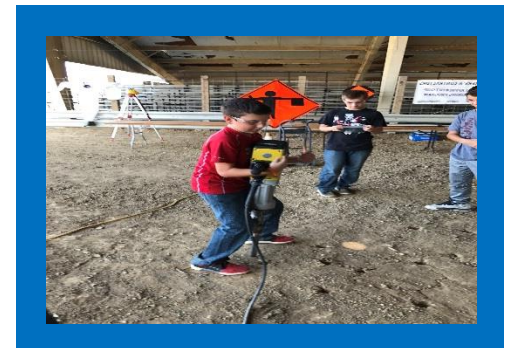
