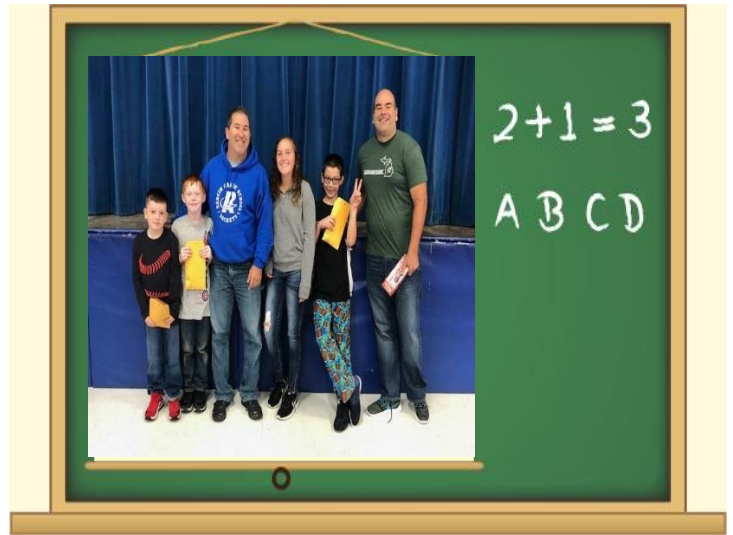

Student Council is open to all 5th – 8th grade students who are interested in learning leadership skills while helping their school and community.

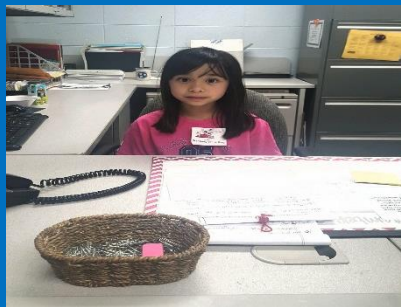
